TVS suggests that rent payments should be reported via <u>landlordcreditbureau.com</u> each month. The Landlord Credit Bureau reports rent payments to Equifax Credit Bureau monthly. Your DOB and last 4 digits of SSN (optional) are requested to ensure accurate reporting by the Landlord Credit Bureau and Equifax Credit Bureau.
Tenants who make their rent payments on time and abide by the rules of the tenancy agreement can be rewarded with a Certificate of Satisfactory Tenancy at the end of a tenancy by this Landlord.
Future Landlords or Property Managers can verify good tenancy at <u>landlordcreditbureau.com</u> .
Tenants that are late with rent payments and/or leave landlords stuck with unpaid rent, and/or damaged rental property, may find it difficult to obtain tenancy in the future given a negative tenant history.
Paying rent on time is your responsibility and forms part of the tenancy agreement which is a contract that you are about to sign. Breaching the terms of a contract is a serious matter for which there are consequences.
You can sign up at landlordcreditbureau com for a small annual fee to monitor your Landlord Credit Bureau account.
You are entitled to one FREE Landford Credit Burgay report annually.
Submit a request to <u>customerservice@landlordcreditburead.com</u> and attach (scan) two pieces of identification; one piece of Identification must have your photo. EG driver's license, passport, government issued ID.
NOTE: Documentation as noted above is required to verify your identity.
